
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Integration... What do we mean?

► Integration within theories




Important Aspects of Theories

- ► Explanatory system
- ► Testable hypotheses to guide research and, potentially, practice
- Immediate implications for practice are a plus, not a necessity

What are the Barriers to Theory-Research-Practice Integration?




Beware the Silos

Some Solutions – None really original

- ► Theory-Research Linkages theorists need to provide:
 - Clear definitions of central concepts
 - ▶ Testable hypotheses
 - Research showing how the theory can be tested
 - ► Accessible and (ideally) free measures

Some Solutions

- ▶ Theory-Practice Linkages facilitated by
 - ▶ Provision of case examples by theorists
 - Research creating and testing theorybased interventions
 - ▶Theorists working with creative practitioners

Some Solutions

- ▶ Research-Practice Linkages facilitated by
 - Researchers avoiding pursuit of complexity as an end in itself
 - ► Practitioners seeing "practice-far" research as part of programmatic inquiry
 - ► Collaborations, dialogues, attendance at same conferences
