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Quality

- Quality of **resources**
 - Assessments
 - Information
- Quality of **services**
 - Training of the practitioner
 - Experience of the practitioner
 - Supervision of the practitioner

Readiness for Self-Help Resources

- Appropriate for persons with **high** readiness for career decision making
- Inappropriate for persons with **low** readiness for career decision making

Availability of Needed User Support

- Availability of local counseling services (Back-up)
 - Low decision-making readiness
 - Mental health problems
 - Importance of screening

Credentials of Providers

- Vague or not stated
- Demonstrated skills needed in addition to credentials
- Training, experience, and supervision

Awareness of Local Conditions

- Impact of local conditions and events on the needs and mental health of the individual being served at a distance

Confidentiality

- Inappropriate access to counseling records (careless practitioner)

Security

- Inappropriate access to counseling records (technology problem)

Privacy

- Potential negative influence of others related to Internet use
- Auditory and visual privacy

Equality of Access

- Limited financial resources
- Physical access related to disability
