

2010 Graduating Senior Survey and Follow-up Data

General Information for All Colleges

Graduating seniors were asked to complete an on line survey regarding their post-graduate plans during April 2010. 1,872 completed responses were received from 6,340 graduating seniors, representing a 30% response rate. Six months post-graduate seniors who indicated that they were still seeking employment, waiting on graduate/professional school admission, or taking time off were surveyed again in November 2010. Completed responses to the follow-up survey were received from 154 of the 917 graduates who provide follow-up contact information in the initial survey, representing a 17% response rate. A brief summary of our findings follow:
