Florida State University Spring 2009 Graduating Senior Survey and Follow-up Data **General Information for All Colleges**

Graduating seniors were asked to complete an on line survey regarding their post-graduate plans during April 2009. Completed surveys were received from 744 of the 5,514 graduates, representing a 13.5% response rate. Typically, many seniors do not have established plans at graduation; 102 seniors who noted that they were still seeking employment or graduate school admission were surveyed again six months following graduation. Completed surveys for the six-month follow-up were received from 11 of the 23 graduates who provide followup contact information during Fall 2009, representing a 48% response rate. A brief summary of our findings follow:
