

Exploring Your Values, Interests & Skills

Objectives

1. To help you examine your values, interests, and skills.
2. To help you relate your self-knowledge to occupational, educational, training, or employment options.

Rationale

This Quick Guide identifies self-assessment activities available to you that may prove to be interesting, fun, and informative. In consultation with a Career Advisor, you may complete any of these activities with respect to your needs. When you have completed the selected activities, you are encouraged to meet with a Career Advisor again to discuss the results of your self-assessment and the implications for your career development.

A critical part of learning how to make career decisions involves looking at yourself and asking:

- *What activities am I interested in?*
- *What values do I have that might be an important part of exploring possible occupational, educational, training, or employment options.*
- *What skills and abilities do I possess, want to use, and/or need to develop?*

The answers to these “I” questions are important because they provide useful information for making career decisions and solving career problems throughout one’s life. This self-knowledge helps to expand and then narrow the options you are considering at any given point in life.

Activities for Exploring Interests

- Complete the Self-Directed Search (SDS), computer or paper version (ask a Career Advisor for access to either format).
