

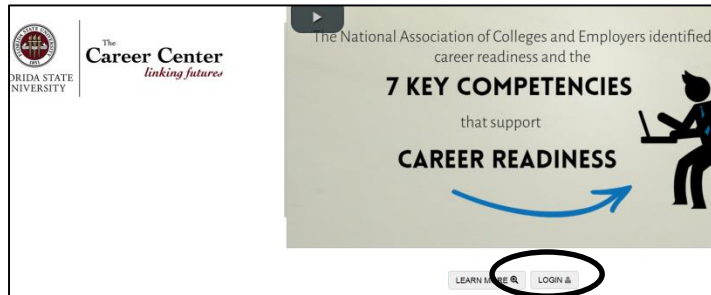


## The Career Platform

**The Career Platform** is FSU's online learning system for employability skill-building. ### Create a New Account

To create an account, click on the "Login" button in the bottom right corner of the Career Platform's homepage. Click "Sign up for a Purposely Account" and enter the requested information into each field. When finished, select "Create Account."

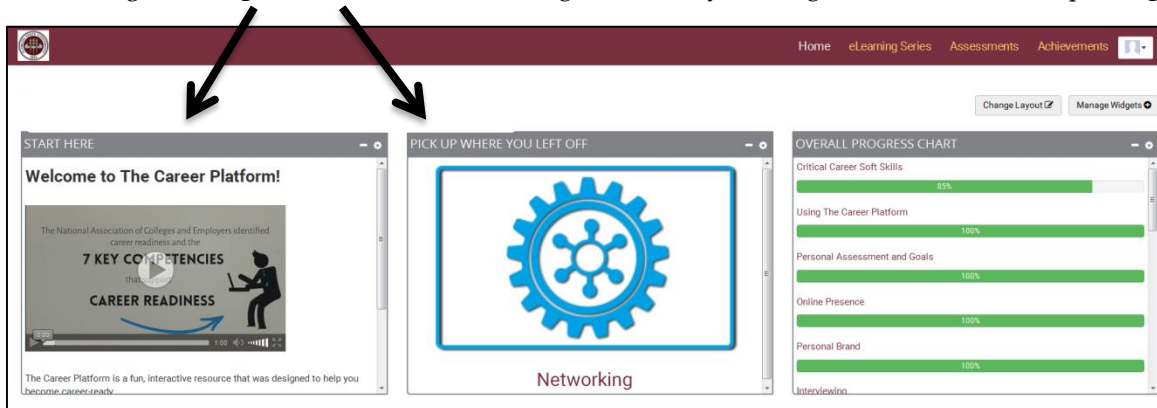


### Sign In Using an Existing Account

To sign in, go to the Career Platform log-in page (listed above) click on the "LOGIN" button in the bottom right corner of the Career Platform's homepage. Enter the username/email and password you used to create your account into the fields of the pop-up window. When finished, click the "Log In" button.
